Changes to Fall Leaf Collection

in Seaforth, Egmondville, Harpurhey, Brussels & Vanastra

Leaves will **ONLY** be collected in **COMPOSTABLE PAPER** yard bags, available for purchase at many hardware & grocery stores. Huron East staff will collect leaf bags left at the curb in a timely manner in October & November. Leaf pick-up in this manner is the most **COST-EFFECTIVE, RELIABLE & CONSISTENT** way to collect leaves in urban areas.

An even better way to deal with leaves is to mulch them with your lawnmower. This keeps them from blowing around & provides excellent nutrients for healthy lawns! To keep our roads safe & storm drains clear, please **DO NOT** rake leaves to the curb.

Huron East Fire Department Update

The Huron East Fire Department is urging you to test your Smoke & Carbon Monoxide Alarms. 2022 was the deadliest year for fire-related deaths in Ontario in more than two decades with 133 people losing their lives. Many of these fatal fires happened in homes that did not have working smoke alarms.

The Ontario Fire Code requires every home in Ontario to have a working smoke alarm on every storey and outside of all sleeping areas and carbon monoxide alarms adjacent to each sleeping area of a home if you have a fuel-burning appliance, a fireplace or an attached garage.

The penalty for not having the proper smoke or carbon monoxide alarm can range from a \$295 ticket plus surcharge per alarm up to \$50,000 for individuals and \$100,000 for corporations.

Only working smoke & carbon monoxide alarms save lives!
