TREE PLANTING PROGRAM

I DEFINITIONS

Municipal Property: Shall mean any property leased or owned by the Municipality of Huron East and shall include road allowances under the jurisdiction of Huron East.

II TREE REPLACEMENT

The Municipality of Huron East shall plant a new tree to replace each tree it cuts down as a result of disease or nuisance. Trees shall be ordered each spring from the Maitland Valley Conservation Authority to replace trees cut in the previous year.

III ROADSIDE TREE PLANTING PROGRAM

- ❖ The Municipality of Huron East shall order, in addition to the replacement trees required in a given year, an additional 120 trees for distribution to property owners.
- ❖ The Roadside Tree Planting Program will be advertised each year in the Huron East Fall Newsletter.
- ❖ Orders will be taken on a first come, first served basis with a maximum of 5 trees per landowner/homeowner.
- ❖ Landowners can indicate their preference for oak or maple trees, however, there will be no guarantees.
- ❖ The Public Works Department will deliver the trees to the homeowners.
- ❖ It is the responsibility of the homeowner to plant, water and care for the trees.
- ❖ The trees are to be planted inside the homeowner's property line along the roadside, but not in the boulevard area.
- ❖ Trees are approximately 6 feet tall and bare root.
