

Property Taxes/Utilities:

Huron East issues two tax bills annually:

- The **Interim tax bills** contain installments due the last business days of March and June.
- The **Final tax bills** contain installments due the last business days of September and November.

Utility Bills are issued quarterly:

- In March, June, September, and December; all due on the last business day of the month

The Municipality offers many ways for you to pay your property tax and utility bill:

- Pre-Authorized Payment Plan
- Internet Banking
- By Mail
- In Person

Garbage & Recycling:

Huron East's recycling and garbage system is provided by Bluewater Recycling:

- Runs on a bi-weekly system
- Seaforth, Vanastra, Harpurhey, Egmondville, Bridges, McKillop, and Grey areas are all picked up on Fridays
- Brussels and Tuckersmith are picked up on Wednesdays

Dog Tags:



In Huron East if you have a dog you must register for a dog tag:

- To apply for a dog license/tag use the form on our website
- Payments can be made by e-transfer to **payments@huroneast.com**, in person, or the drop box at our office
- Huron East has a perpetual system, the Dog Tag assigned to your dog will remain with them for the course of their life
- The flat fee for one altered dog is \$20.00, however prices may differ depending on the amount of dogs and alter status

Some frequently asked questions are:

Do I need a permit to build a fence on my property?

- No, you do not need to apply for a building permit to build a fence!

What is the maximum height to build a deck without needing a permit?

- Anything under 2ft does not require a permit to build!

What is the area of a shed that does not need a permit?

- If your shed you plan to build is under 160 square feet and does not have any plumbing you do not need a permit!
