## Paving the way for a better Seaforth

### Revised Detour Notice

Friday, June 12th, 2020

**PLEASE NOTE** that access into the FOODLAND parking lot will revert back to its original entrance at George & Main Streets. Just continue to follow the yellow and black signs installed along the route to find your way. Your patience through this construction is greatly appreciated.

#### Construction Updates for the coming week:

##### Crew 1

- Will be installing the mainline storm sewer and water main from George Street to Market Street. The **ROAD CLOSED** sign will be moved to Main and John Streets as Stage 4 goes through the Market Street intersection.

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- Will be testing the temporary water main from Market Street to Highway 8.
- Testing the water main from Station Road to George Street.
- Installing water and storm services from George Street to Market Street. Sidewalk removals from George Street to Market Street.
- Building the remainder of road from Station to George Street.
- Picards will continue to install a new Bell duct structure from the southern Foodland entrance through George Street.
- KWS will be installing electrical ducts between Station Road and George Street including George Street crossing.



#### Phase 1 Clean Up:

- The sodding is almost complete except for a small area along the Egmondville United Church, which will require sod after the sidewalk has been laid. The concrete sidewalk along the church and some concrete drives on Thompson Street have been scheduled for June 15th. The high back curb that was to be a roll-over curb for snow plowing needs is to be removed and replaced.
