Road Construction Up-date for Week of June 15th, 2020

Paving the Way for a Better Seaforth

Revised Foodland Detour Notice This Week Starting Monday June 15th, 2020

PLEASE NOTE that the access into the FOODLAND parking lot has returned to its original entrance at George & Main Streets. **Note:** All traffic will flow from Goderich Street (Hwy 8) to Victoria Street to George Street. Just continue to follow the yellow and black signs installed along the route to find your way. Your patience through this construction is greatly appreciated.

Construction Updates for the coming week:

- Continue to install watermain between George and Market Streets
- Install storm and water services between George and Market Streets
- **REMOVAL** of west & east sidewalks along Main Street between Market and John Streets. There will be a one-metre strip installed along the storefronts to allow access into the businesses prior to the installation of the new sidewalks.
- REMOVAL of asphalt on Main Street between Market & John Streets. Note: Main Street is now closed between these two points, as well access points along this stretch.
- Tie-in temporary water services between Market and John Streets when water samples have passed inspection
- Continue to test watermain between Station Road and George Street
- Tie-in Crombie Street watermain when water samples have passed inspection
- **REMOVAL** of **west & east** sidewalks between George and Market Streets
- Municipal parking lot behind Town Hall will be closed Monday & Tuesday for line-painting

Subcontractors:

- Bell will install new duct structure across Main Street just north of George Street
- Install street light duct between Huron Street and south of Foodland entrance
- Concrete sub-contractors are scheduled to set a string line for curbs after June 23rd (Station Road to south of George Street)

Phase 1 Clean Up:

 Install new laneways and sidewalks on North and Thompson Streets, as well as, fix curb issue
