

HURON EAST LEAF COLLECTION

Begins October 19, 2020 and ends November 13, 2020 (approx.)

(leaf collection is weather dependent; stop raking once it snows)

- Monday/Tuesday/Wednesday in Seaforth/Egmondville/Harpurhey
- Thursday/Friday in Brussels

The Leaf Sucker will pick up leaves raked into windrows at the curb. No need to call the office after you've raked – the leaf sucker follows a continuous route and will be back in your neighbourhood again in a week or two.

Mulch - mulching your leaves saves time, energy and your back by not raking! Cut up the leaves with your lawnmower and blow them back onto your property so they don't create a mess on our roads and sidewalks.

Compost - you can take yard and garden waste to the Municipal Compost Sites at 79522 Hannah Line in Harpurhey and 108 Turnberry Street in Brussels, and place it in the areas marked COMPOST. Do not leave bags, boxes, containers or garbage at the compost sites.

Bag – put your leaves in paper yard waste bags at the curb to be collected in a timely manner. (Huron East does not provide bags.)

Please do not blow mulched leaves or grass onto sidewalks or road edges, this creates slippery surfaces for pedestrians, cyclists & drivers and is an offence (Section 180 Highway Traffic Act).

The leaf sucker is not able to pick up mulched leaves or grass.

Debris on the road clogs our catchbasins, leading to flooding after heavy rains.

Fall Pick Up in Vanastra - November 6 and 20

Brush clippings, leaves and garden refuse must be bundled, tied or in paper bags for pick up at curbside on these 2 dates.
