Construction Update for this Week:

- Watermain testing between John Street and Hwy 8
- Build road between John Street and Hwy 8
- Water service connections between Market Street and John Street
- Storm and watermain installation between Railway Street and Station Road
- Install Bell duct structure between Market Street and John Street
- Install electrical work between Market Street and John Street
- Light pole installation between George Street and Market Street
- Window well modifications between Market Street and Hwy 8

Entrance into the Foodland parking lot will revert back to George Street (Seaforth Library) via Victoria Street.


Access to S. J. Fritzley Auto Repair, Janet's Cafe, Seaforth Car Wash and Rona Seaforth will remain the same .

A **NEW PARKING LOT** is **also open** immediately east of Seaforth Plumbing & Heating at the corner of Goderich & Victoria Streets. We encourage you to use it.
