


Newsletter # 2 – Seaforth Main Street Construction Update as of Tuesday, April 14th, 2020

Phase 2 of Seaforth Main Street road construction has been deemed an essential service by the Province of Ontario, the Municipality of Huron East and the County of Huron. As a result, the contractor has initiated a Covid-19 Action Plan for its employees and sub-contractors to ensure the safety of all workers and will mobilize and commence Phase 2 construction on Monday, April 20th, 2020.



Construction will begin at the corner of Crombie Street & Main Street preceding north to the traffic lights at the main intersection. This encompasses Stages 3, 4, 5, and 6. The construction project involves the installation of; watermains, storm sewers, sidewalks, curbs, street light poles and road replacement. The first stage (Stage 3, 4) will be from Crombie Street to George Street and then George Street to Market Street. Once completed to road base condition, construction will continue in the staged order of 5 and 6. Detour for this section from Goderich Street (Hwy 8) will be south onto Jarvis Street to Station Street and then back to Main Street (County Road 12) as indicated on the Detour map for Phase 4, 5, 6.
