Road Construction Up-date for Week of August 16th, 2020

Paving the Way for a Better Seaforth

Construction Update for this Week:

- Removal of structures under sidewalk at 20 and 22 Main Street South.
- Window well modifications between Market Street and Hwy 8.
- Install watermain connection at Gouinlock Street.
- Install water service connections between Market Street and John Street.
- Install storm sewer and watermain between Railway Street West and Station Road.
- Install remainder of storm and water services between John Street and Hwy 8.
- Build roadway between John Street and Hwy 8.
- Bell Structure work between Market Street and John Street.
- Electrical work between Gouinlock Street and John Street.

ACCESS UPDATE for Foodland, Janet's Cafe, S. J. Fritzley Auto Repair, Rona, & Seaforth Car Wash

Entrance into the Foodland parking will remain the same for the coming week with access from Huron Street & Crombie Street.

Watch for the yellow and black detour signs along Jarvis, Railway, Sills & Brantford Streets to guide you to S. J. Fritzley Auto Repair, Janet's Cafe, Seaforth Car Wash and Rona Seaforth.

Parking at the municipal lots on John Street, behind Town Hall and Victoria Park. Watch for the **yellow & black** directional parking signs, and the round green universal signs marked with a "P" to guide you. Some side street parking is also available. A **NEW PARKING LOT** is **also open** immediately east of Seaforth Plumbing & Heating at the corner of Goderich & Victoria Streets. We encourage you to use it.
