Paving the Way for a Better Seaforth

Construction Update for this Week:

- Build roadway between Station Road & Railway Street West.
- Watermain tie-ins between Station Road & Railway Street West. *This will result in some water interruptions. Property & business owners will be notified prior to shutdown.*
- Water service connections between John Street & Hwy 8.
- John Street Watermain tie-ins. *This will result in some water interruptions. Property & business owners will be notified prior to shutdown.*
- Window well modifications between John Street & Hwy 8
- Pull electrical wire between Market Street & Hwy 8



Construction Time Lines for September & October 2020

- Concrete curbs & sidewalks to begin week of September 21st. This work will continue for approximately 3 weeks.
- Asphalt paving to begin mid-to-late October.
- The earliest Main Street will be **OPEN** is October 23rd.

All dates are subject to change due to weather and unforeseen circumstances.

FOODLAND PARKING LOT ACCESS

Entrance into the Foodland parking lot will continue by way of George Street (Seaforth Library).

Access to S. J. Fritzley Auto Repair, Janet's Cafe, Seaforth Car Wash and Rona Seaforth will also remain the same.

Watch for the yellow and black detour signs along Jarvis, Railway, Sills & Brantford Streets and Kippen Road to guide you.

DOWNTOWN PARKING

FREE Parking continues in the municipal lots on John Street, behind Town Hall and Victoria Park. Watch for the **YELLOW & BLACK** directional parking signs, and the round green universal signs marked with a "P" to guide you. Some side street parking is also available. A **NEW PARKING LOT** is *also open* immediately east of Seaforth Plumbing & Heating at the corner of Goderich & Victoria Streets. We encourage you to use it.
