Road Construction Up-date for Week of July 6th, 2020

Paving the Way for a Better Seaforth



We're on the move again

- This week expect **asphalt** and **sidewalk removals** from John Street to HWY 8.
- Special shout-out to Dene Coombs for all her amazing photography of the road construction these past weeks. Great work, Dene!

Construction Update for this week:

- * Asphalt paving from Station Road to George Street
- * Watermain testing from George Street to Market Street
- * Road building from Market Street to Gouinlock Street
- * Water and storm services from Market Street to John Street
- * Temporary water service connections between John Street & HWY 8
(west side only)
- * Main line storm sewer and watermain from John Street towards HWY 8
- * Bell duct structure from George Street to Market Street
- * Street light duct from George Street to Market Street



DOWNTOWN PARKING

As construction continues to move north on Main Street, parking will become more limited. However, there is space at the municipal lots at John & Main Streets and behind Town Hall. Watch for the **yellow & black** directional parking signs, and the round universal green signs marked with a "P" to guide you.

A **NEW PARKING LOT** is **NOW** available east of Seaforth Heating & Plumbing at the corner of Goderich & Victoria Streets.

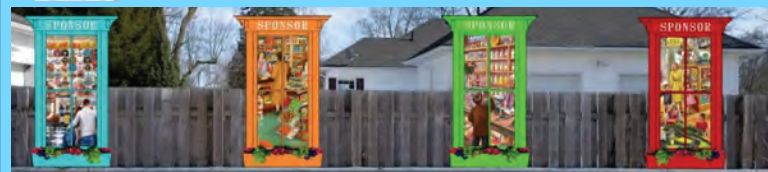
