Road Construction Up-date for Week of August 2nd, 2020

Paving the Way for a Better Seaforth

Construction Update for this Week:

- Install concrete curbs from George Street through Market Street
- Continue with storm & water services between John Street & Hwy 8 (Goderich St)
- Place gravel between new curbs from George Street to Market Street
- Remove asphalt on Main Street South between Station Road & Railway Street West. **Note: Station Road to be closed while work continues in this area.**
- Set up temporary watermain between Station Road West & Railway tracks.
- Detour to be re-routed across the Jarvis Street RAILROAD crossing. **(Note: Businesses located south of tracks on Main Street will still be accessible.)**
- Test watermain between Market Street & John Street
- Install Bell duct between Market Street & John Street
- Install street light conduit between Market Street & John Street
- Filling in existing window wells to continue

Access to Foodland Update

The south access into the Foodland parking lot will continue until Tuesday, August 11th by way of the 2 routes below;

1. From Victoria street turn west onto Crombie Street, then turn right onto Main Street at Bethel Bible Church, or;
2. From Jarvis Street (detour route) turn east onto Huron Street, travel to the Seaforth Legion then left onto Main Street.

Continue to watch for the yellow and black detour signs along the route to guide you and for the new "All Way Stops" at Jarvis, Market & John Streets.

DOWNTOWN PARKING

There is parking at the municipal lots on John Street & Main Street and also behind Town Hall & Victoria Park. Watch for the **yellow & black** directional parking signs, and the round green universal signs marked with a "P" to guide you. Some side street parking is also available.

A **NEW PARKING LOT** is **NOW** open immediately east of Seaforth Plumbing & Heating at the corner of Goderich & Victoria Streets. We encourage you to use it. Check out our newest mural "It's Time to Explore Your Backyard" sponsored by Ontario's West Coast Huron County's Cultural Services Department.
