Up-date for Upcoming Week of October 4th, 2020

Paving the Way for a Better Seaforth

Construction Update for the coming Week:

- Continue to pour concrete sidewalks from Railway Street to Hwy 8. This will continue for another 2 1/2 weeks and is weather dependant.
- Installation of new light poles from the railway tracks to Hwy 8.
- Fine grade the roadway gravel.
- Set Bell manholes to grade in sidewalks.

Construction Time Lines for Month of October 2020

- Installation of concrete curbs & sidewalks to continue for approx. 2 1/2 more weeks.
- Asphalt paving to begin mid-to-late October.
- The earliest date Main Street is expected to **RE-OPEN** is October 23rd.

All dates are subject due to weather or any other unforeseen circumstances.

Access to Foodland via George Street (Library)



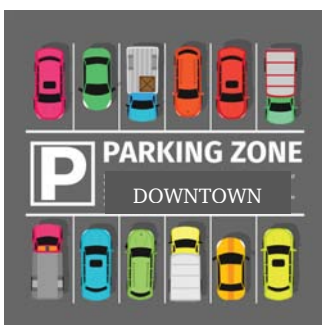
When you see the **flashing lights** of emergency vehicles while travelling on ALL roads, including the Detour Route

Entrance into the Foodland parking lot will continue by way of George Street (Seaforth Library).

Access to S. J. Fritzley Auto Repair, Everspring Farms, Janet's Cafe, Seaforth Car Wash and Rona Seaforth will also remain the same.

Watch for the yellow and black detour signs along Jarvis, Railway, Sills & Brantford Streets and Kippen Road to guide you.



FREE Parking continues in the municipal lots on John Street, behind Town Hall and Victoria Park. Watch for the **YELLOW & BLACK** directional parking signs, and the round green universal signs marked with a "P" to guide you. Some side street parking is also available. A **NEW PARKING LOT** is **also open** immediately east of Seaforth Plumbing & Heating at the corner of Goderich & Victoria Streets. We encourage you to use it.
