Up-date for Week of October 12th, 2020

Paving the Way for a Better Seaforth

Construction Update for this Week:

- Continue to install concrete sidewalks to Hwy 8
- Grade parking stalls along Main Street
- Continue to install new street light poles and crosswalk
- Install water service to Post Office and Ralph Smith's Law Office on Wednesday October 14th. Water will be shut off to these two locations 'only' from 8:30 am to 4:30 pm. (Access to back alley will be limited at both ends during this time. If possible, please park behind Town Hall or in the parking lot beside Seaforth Plumbing & Heating during this time. Many thanks!)

IMPORTANT MESSAGE TO BUSINESS & PROPERTY OWNERS LOCATED ALONG MAIN STREET, WHO DO NOT HAVE SIDEWALKS.

When concrete work is being completed for the sidewalks, a ramp will be installed from the edge of the form to the building

entrance. The ramps will be removed for the time it takes to finish the concrete work and then re-installed until the cement hardens. We will make every effort to keep everyone up to date with the sidewalk progress.

Construction Time Lines for October 2020

- Installation of concrete sidewalks to continue for approximately 2 more weeks.
- Installation of asphalt to continue until mid-to-late October.
- The earliest date Main Street is expected to be *RE-OPEN* is October 23rd.

All dates are subject to change due to weather or other unforeseen circumstances.

FOODLAND PARKING LOT ACCESS

Entrance into Foodland parking lot will continue via George Street (Seaforth Library). Access to S. J. Fritzley Auto Repair, Everspring Farms, Janet's Cafe, Seaforth Car Wash and Rona Seaforth will also remain the same.

Watch for the yellow and black detour signs along Jarvis, Railway, Sills & Brantford Streets and Kippen Road to guide you.



FREE Parking continues in the municipal lots on John Street, behind Town Hall and Victoria Park. Watch for the **YELLOW & BLACK** directional parking signs, and the round green universal signs marked with a "**P**" to guide you. Some side street parking is also available. A **NEW PARKING LOT** is *also open* immediately east of Seaforth Plumbing & Heating at the corner of Goderich & Victoria Streets. We encourage you to use it.
