
Paving the Way for a Better Seaforth

Construction Update for the coming Week:

- Continue with concrete sidewalks (John Street to Hwy 8 to be done first followed by John Street to Market Street)
- Prepare boulevards for asphalt
- Continue to wire new street light poles
- Install poles for pedestrian crossing

IMPORTANT MESSAGE TO BUSINESS & PROPERTY OWNERS LOCATED ALONG MAIN STREET, WHO DO NOT HAVE SIDEWALKS.

When concrete work is being completed for the sidewalks, ramps will be installed from the edge of the forms to the individual building entrances. The ramps will be removed for the time it takes to finish the concrete work and then re-installed until the cement hardens. We will make every effort to keep everyone up to date with the sidewalk progress.

• Installation of concrete sidewalks to continue for approximately 2 more weeks.

FOODLAND PARKING LOT ACCESS


