Paving the Way for a Better Seaforth

Construction Update for the coming Week:

- Complete the concrete sidewalks
- Install the pedestrian crosswalk poles at Gouinlock Street
- Complete street lighting
- Place topsoil
- Pave the parking stalls & miscellaneous areas beginning at Railway Street West moving north, and bench and parge storm structures

All dates are subject to change due to weather or other unforeseen circumstances.

IMPORTANT MESSAGE TO BUSINESS & PROPERTY OWNERS LOCATED ALONG MAIN STREET, WHO DO NOT HAVE SIDEWALKS

When concrete work is being completed for the sidewalks, ramps will be installed from the edge of the forms to the individual building entrances. The ramps will be removed for the time it takes to finish the concrete work and then re-installed until the cement hardens. We will make every effort to keep everyone up to date with the sidewalk progress.


