Paving the Way for a Better Seaforth

Construction Update for the coming Week:

- Storm sewer benching and parging.
- Sweeping of the sidewalks.
- Wire GFCI plugs on the street lights.
- Install the remaining Street light in front of Town Hall.
- Install water bottle fill station beside Town Hall.

County Road 12 (Main Street) will begin to open on Monday, November 2nd, 2020. It will be open from Railway Street West to Crombie Street and continue to open block by block heading north as each block gets finished.

Note: The Jarvis Street railway crossing will be closed on Monday and traffic will be directed to use the new Main Street railway crossing from now on.
