Up-date for Week of November 7th, 2020

Paving the Way for a Better Seaforth

Construction Update for the Coming Week:

- Continue with manhole paring and benching
- Installation of pedestrian crosswalk poles
- Install concrete paving stones
- Prep and pave the Hwy 8 and Main Street intersection (*there will be a traffic control crew directing traffic Monday - Thursday while work takes place.*)
- Complete miscellaneous and boulevard paving
- Replace asphalt patch from last year's project
- Install gates at the Jarvis Street train tracks

Note: Main Street will be open starting the week-end of November 7th from its southend to Market Street. Although, Main Street between Huron and Crombie Streets will need to be closed for a half-day during the coming week to complete the benching.

Main Street will be open at the end of the day on Friday, November 13th, 2020.

All dates are subject to change due to weather or other unforeseen circumstances.
