- Water and Wastewater services and emergency response are proceeding as usual.
- **The Municipal Administration Office (72 Main St, S., Seaforth) is closed to in person transactions.** We can accept applications through the mail, via email or through our online services. We would like to remind all residents that payments relating to utility and tax bills can be made online through your bank or you may register to have payments debited directly from your account through pre-authorized payments.
- All Huron East recreational facilities and halls will be closed to the public. Staff members are available by email to answer any questions.
- The Building Department office will be closed to the public. Staff members are available by telephone (519-527-1710 ext 30 or 31) and email to answer your questions. If you need to drop off an application or request an inspection please call ahead to discuss with staff.
